A DUI attorney can clarify the possibilities

There are a number of factors that can affect how your DUI/DWI case is treated. An experienced criminal lawyer can talk you through the details of how each of these variables can influence your particular case:

- **BAC.** [Your blood alcohol concentration](#) (BAC) will determine whether you face charges of driving while ability impaired (DWAI), driving while intoxicated (DWI) or aggravated driving while intoxicated (ADWI). These distinctions are based on the amount of alcohol found in your blood stream and come with different levels of consequences, fines and mandatory minimums.
- **Age.** New York has a zero tolerance policy when it comes to underage drinking. The legal BAC level for anyone under the age of 21 is lower than those who are over the legal drinking age. Penalties for underage drinking are tailored specifically to meet these situations.
- **Injured parties.** If additional parties are injured or killed due to an accident caused by a DUI, additional criminal charges or civil cases may also be brought against the driver.
- **Previous offenses.** A past record of drunk driving convictions will influence the charges brought against you in a DUI case. These may include higher fines, increased jail time and extended revocation of your license.
