Types of Theft Offenses

Theft crimes are serious offenses and include robbery, burglary, shoplifting, motor vehicle theft, credit card theft, identity theft and possession of stolen property. There are two categories of theft crimes: petty theft (Petit Larceny) and grand theft (Grand Larceny).

Petty theft involves property valued at less than \$1,000, is usually considered a misdemeanor and is often prosecuted under New York Penal Law 155.25 or [165.40](#). Grand theft, which is usually classified as a felony, involves stolen property valued at more than \$1,000 and is prosecuted depending on the level of the crime. This can range from Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree (New York Penal Law [155.30\(1\)](#)) to Grand Larceny in the First Degree (New York Penal Law 155.42).
